

Privacy Statement

WHAT INFORMATION DO WE GATHER ABOUT YOU?

We collect information from you such as your IP address and access device when you access www.haef.gr. When you subscribe to our email service or register to events through specific online forms you might supply us with such information as your name, address, email, and phone number. You can choose not to provide certain information, but then you might not be able to take advantage of many of our features. Periodically, we may ask you to confirm the accuracy of your information to avoid disruption of services.

WHAT DO WE USE YOUR INFORMATION FOR?

We use your IP address to help diagnose problems with our server and to administer our website by identifying (1) which parts of our site are most heavily used and (2) which portion of our audience comes from within the HAEF network. We do not link IP addresses to anything personally identifiable. This means that user sessions will be tracked, but the users will remain anonymous.

The email address you might provide to subscribe to email service or register through online forms may be used to send you information, respond to inquiries, and/or other requests you might have made through the online forms.

In addition, visitor activity is tracked using Google Analytics. Google Analytics is subject to the privacy policy of Google, Inc., which you can find on Google's website. These data are used to optimize our website for our visitors and do not include personally identifiable information such as name, contact information, or credit card numbers.

All personally identifiable information provided by visitors is strictly reserved for use by HAEF for personal and HAEF-related purposes only.

DEVICE INFORMATION COLLECTED BY US

We may collect non-personal information about the computer, mobile device, or other device you use to access www.haef.gr, such as IP address, geolocation information, unique device identifiers, browser type, browser language, or other information of this nature. We use this information in an aggregate fashion to track access to www.haef.gr. At no time do we disclose site usage by individual IP addresses. Web server logs are retained on a temporary basis and then are deleted from our systems.

THIRD-PARTY COOKIES

Cookies may be set by an organization other than www.haef.gr. These "third-party cookies" may, for example, originate from websites such as YouTube, Twitter, Facebook, Google Plus, or other social media services for which www.haef.gr has implemented "plug-ins." Since the cookie policies of these sites change over time, you should determine their policies by visiting the privacy policy pages of these sites directly.
