

## **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS!**

**Any student whose academics fall below the 14 minimum in the 9 core subjects and the 15 in English no longer have an invitation to join the IBDP Psychico College 2010-2011 Class.**

### **The Appeal Process:**

Students who wish to be considered for the Appeal Process must demonstrate maintenance, and preferably an increase, in their 9 subject average. (Students MUST maintain or increase their average during the second semester. A drop in average could result in a student losing his/her place in the Psychico IB programme.) These students will then have the opportunity to amend their applications with additional recommendation letters, CAS, and attendance at the IB Week-end Workshops. Only then will they be considered for the Appeal Process.

The only opportunity for an appeal of the Committee's admittance decision is the participation in the Psychico Pre-IB Programme. If a student had not been selected, that student must attend the Pre-IB Summer Programme offered by Psychico College, IBDP. It will be an intensive 3 week course that requires full attendance, completion of all assignments, both inside and outside of the classroom, a CAS component, and an examination at the end of each course/week. A minimum overall grade will be required to qualify for re-consideration. Students meeting the minimum requirements will be placed in rank order on the selection list and offered placement based on the pre-decided, fixed student number. Successful completion of the Pre-IB Summer Programme does not guarantee a place in the Psychico IB programme.

### **Student Profile CV Suggestions:**

Students need to submit a word processed profile, a student CV-including but not limited to IB seminar participation, academic history, creative interests, hobbies, athletics, music, dance, cultural interests and participation, any thing and everything you would include about yourself if you were applying for a "job" with the IBDP, Psychico College. This document is your opportunities to tell the IBDP how well suited you are for the programme. The Resume Wizard in Microsoft Word is a great help with the overall structure and form of your document. All application paperwork MUST be turned in to the IB office no later than 03 February 2010-NO EXCEPTIONS; in addition to the student CV, an IB course selection sheet, university aspirations, IBDP application forms, student photo and two teacher evaluations in sealed envelopes must also be included in the student's profile packet. The all forms have been supplied in the application packet and are available on the HAEF IB website using the link to the Application Information 2010.
