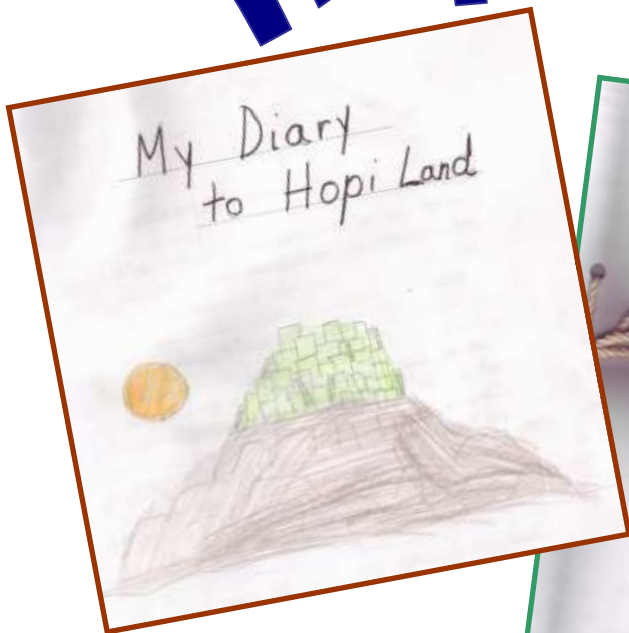
# The Gruffalo

# Hopi Diaries



*Class:* ESL 5

*Teacher:* Mrs. A. Galanis

*Aim:* To teach children about other cultures and to make them aware of the importance of identifying with tradition and the past.

*Step 1:* The students read the story "The Hopi Way" by Mary Eating from their anthology.

*Step 2:* Class discussion. The emphasis is on comprehension and analysis of the text.

*Step 3:* The students focus on the theme and identify with the Indian boy who leaves the city to visit his relatives in a tiny village near the Painted Desert in Arizona and so learn about the ways of the Hopi people and especially about the ritual of the naming ceremony. The children relate the boy's experience to their own experience and become aware of how city children need to keep in touch with their traditions which are often lost in city life.
